

LATVIA'S AID TO UKRAINE

AS OF OCTOBER, 2024

Latvia's GDP (prognoses):

120 billion € (2022 – 2024)

Total aid to Ukraine:

841 million € (0.7% of GDP),
which includes:

■ Military aid to Ukraine:

524 million €

■ Support for war refugees from Ukraine in Latvia:

234 million €

■ Humanitarian aid and support to the Government of Ukraine:

71 million €

■ Reform, development, reconstruction support:

12 million €

■ Military aid

Government of Latvia, including through European Peace Facility (EPF): military assistance to Ukraine.

Equipment: Stinger anti-aircraft missiles, helicopters, howitzers, drones, weapons and personal equipment, dry food rations, ammunition, anti-tank weapons, fuel, etc.

Contribution to NATO Comprehensive Assistance Package for Ukraine.

Private sector & Civil society: military generators, drones, drone catchers, drone 3D tails, quadricycles, military scooters, off-road vehicles, generators, camouflage nets, canned game, trench candles, walkie-talkies, etc.

■ Support for war refugees from Ukraine in Latvia

Refugee Support Action Plan; residence and working permits; grants for employment; start-up allowances; Guaranteed Minimum Income Allowances; state allowances for families; monthly childcare allowances; scholarships; student and children camps; language courses.

■ Humanitarian aid and support to the Government of Ukraine

Government of Latvia: humanitarian aid and support for the Government of Ukraine, including medical equipment, support to critical infrastructure (generators and transformers etc.), etc.

International contributions (grants and guarantees): International Bank for Reconstruction and Development; World Bank programmes for Ukraine; European Investment Bank; European Bank For Reconstruction and Development; International Monetary Fund; initiative "Grain from Ukraine"; International Criminal Court; UN funds (children, women and refugees); European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation (EUROCONTROL); OECD; OSCE; Council of Europe Register of Damage for Ukraine; Ukraine Energy Support Fund (Energy Community); demining organization "The HALO Trust" etc.

Local Governments: vehicles (cars, buses, etc.), computers, transformers, generators, medicine and medical equipment, humanitarian aid, camouflage nets and trench candles supplies, children's and youth camps.

Private sector & Civil society: humanitarian aid and medical aid. Food and hygiene goods, baby food and diapers, medicine, bandaging supplies, equipment and beds for hospitals, warm clothes, micro-generation stations, batteries and charging stations, portable and desktop computers, etc.

■ Reform, development, reconstruction. Support

Government of Latvia: restoration of social infrastructure objects: educational facilities, healthcare facilities; establishment of two women's support and rehabilitation centers; support for the establishment of a Ukraine's Ombudsman's Human Rights Protection Centre in Chernihiv; reconstruction of housing; Latvian experts to provide support for planning and overseeing the reconstruction process; involvement of Latvian businesses in reconstruction.

Government of Latvia (through MFA): grants for development cooperation projects in Ukraine, covering areas, such as good governance and administrative capacity building; strengthening the rule of law; decentralization; fighting corruption and disinformation; support for civil society and democratic engagement; support to independent media; support for war victims (including rehabilitation); strengthening agriculture and export capacity; support for the establishment of medical rehabilitation system; educational programs for Ukrainian young professionals and civil servants.
