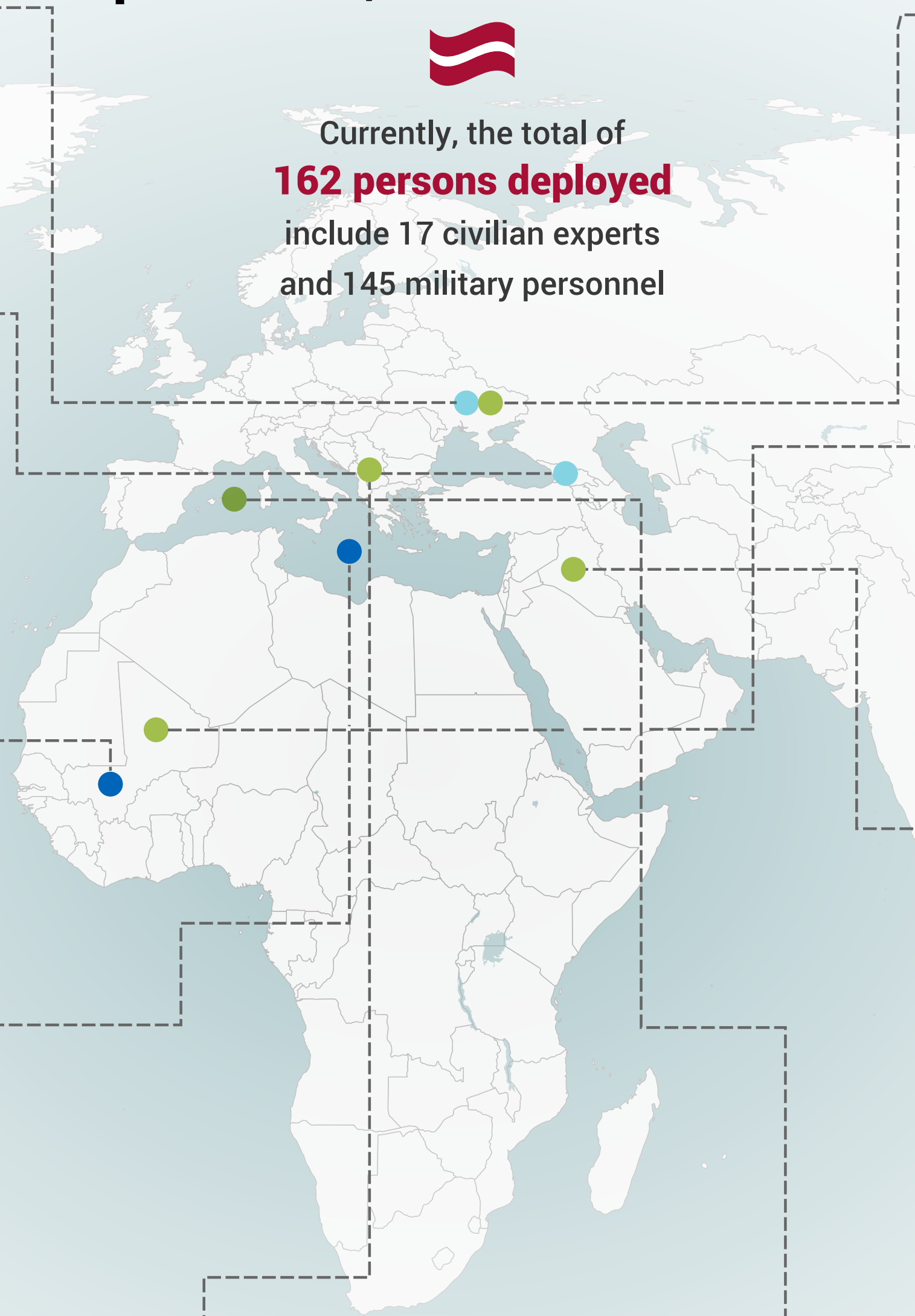


Latvia's Contribution to International Missions and Operations, and other formats

The European Union's civilian missions



8 civilian experts

The EU Advisory Mission Ukraine (EUAM Ukraine)

The mission aims to assist Ukraine towards reforms in the civilian security sector, including justice and home affairs



4 civilian experts

The EU Monitoring Mission Georgia (EUMM Georgia)

The mission is the only international monitor for the Russia-Georgia Six Point Ceasefire Agreement. The mission facilitates reduction of tension between the parties to the conflict, promotes stabilisation and normalisation of the situation.



OSCE missions

The OSCE Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine (OSCE SMM Ukraine)

The mission aims at defusing tension in the conflict zone in the east of Ukraine and promoting peace, stability and security, through providing objective information on the implementation of the Minsk Agreements and violations thereof.



United Nations missions

The United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA)

The main purpose of the mission is to promote stabilisation and development in Mali through enhancing its security forces and protecting the Malian civilians.



The European Union's military operations

The EU Training Mission Mali (EUTM Mali)

The mission aims at improving operational capabilities of the Malian Armed Forces through training and promotes the political control of Malian authorities over the country's military.

The EU operation in the Mediterranean (EUNAVFOR MED IRINI)

The operation's core task of the operation is monitoring of the implementation of the UN arms embargo through the use of aerial, satellite and maritime assets.

The Combined Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve (Iraq)

Following the defeat of ISIL in the territory of Iraq, the Joint Task Force manned by the Global Coalition to Defeat ISIL is currently focusing on the development and improvement of the Iraqi security forces.

NATO Mission in Kosovo Kosovo Force – (KFOR)



Main tasks - patrolling, protecting their forces, maintaining combat capabilities, training, and rapid response tasks.

Other formats



European Border and Coast Guard Agency (FRONTEX Agency) Joint Operations

Currently Latvia ensures participation of the State Border Guard and the State Police officers and the State Border Guard technical equipment in various Joint Operations coordinated by FRONTEX Agency, which are organised at the external borders of the European Union (sea, land, air borders) and in third countries. Aim of these Joint Operations are to support EU Member States, which face challenges, including illegal immigration, present or future threats at their external borders or cross-border crime, as well as provide increased technical and operational assistance implementing external border control.
